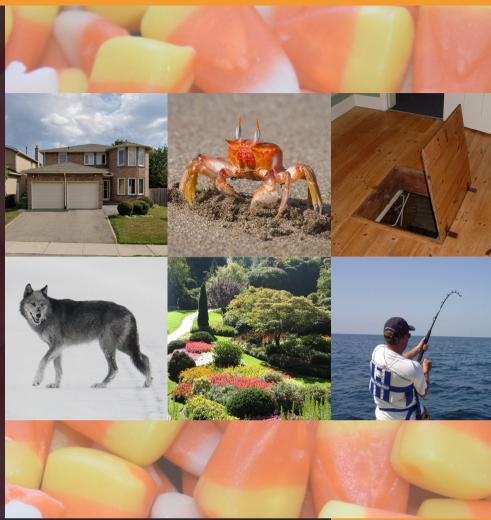
EEK! I'm deathly afraid of it, but I'm much too scared to utter its name, let alone look at it!
